## **LIBRARY**

The college library is enriched with a treasure of 4183 text books and reference books and around 194 books of Placement Cell, 10 National Dailies and 10 Magazines. This year also a grant of Rs. 1,50,000/- was received from the Deptt. of Higher Education, Haryana vide letter no. 9/2-2018 Lib (3) dated 4/12/2018. The grant was consumed in purchasing one vacuum cleaner, 2 Air Conditioner and 128 books. There are ..... computers in the library and whole data of books and I-Cards of students is maintained.

All the books including the books of placement cell provide a sound foundation to the student's knowledge and career.

## **ENGLISH LANGUAGE LAB**

Digital Communication enhancement skills lab with English teaching software has been established by the Department of Higher Education, Haryana. There are 25 computers to

accommodate 25 students at a time. This lab is helpful in enhancing employability skills of students and improve their communication skills of English Language.

## **COMPUTER EDUCATION**

We have two well equipped computer lab with modern amenities. Under the incharge of Sh. Rakesh Jain assisted by Sh. Jaspal Singh L.A., compulsory computer education is also being imparted to all the students of TDC I of the college. We have 43 computers in two labs along with 2 printers cum scanners, computer networking in one lab and internet facility to cater to the needs of the students.

## **PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT AND PLACEMENT CELL**

There is a placement cell in the college that provides consulting and preliminary training through orientation programs, workshops and extension lectures to the students. This cell is managed by Dr. Ravinder Singh, Assistant Professor of Public Administration. Extension Lectures were organised and eminent scholars from KUK and other institutes delivered knowledgeable talks for career development of the students. Dr. Sunil Taneja, Assistant Professor, G.C. Chhachhrauli delivered lecture on 'Career opportunities in IT Sector' on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2018. Sh. Rampal Saini, DDA, Police Academy, Madhuban, Karnal discussed 'Personality Traits' with the students on 16<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2019. 57 students of our college participated in Job Fair held at G.C. Panchkula and 18 students were selected there. Books worth Rs. 21,771/- were purchased for competitive exams. Personality Development and Soft Skills Programme was conducted by Medha Foundation, International NGO, with collaboration of Placement Cell. Total 33 students from Commerce, Arts and Science streams of the college participated in this programme and two of them Menshi and Subhpreet from B.Sc. got placement in VIEC company, Pehowa and Grey Matters, Company (Pehowa) respectively. Sh. Divyanshu from MEDHA Foundation gave this training from 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019 to 13<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

## **EARN WHILE YOU LEARN**

Earn While You Learn scheme has been introduced by Haryana Govt. and the same is being implemented in our college under the convenership of Mrs. Manjeet Kaur, Assistant Professor of English assisted by the committee members. Main objective of this scheme is to harness the energy and capacity of young students create the spirit of work culture and dignity of labour increasing confidence of the students. Needy and meritorious students are selected through transparent process by the committee. Govt. College, Bherian was allotted grant of Rs 50,000/- under the scheme EWYL during the session 2018-19. This year also a grant of Rs. 33,48000/- under consolidated stipend scheme for SC students and Rs. 5,58,000/- for books was received from the Department of Higher Education, Haryana and 279 students were benefitted under SC category. Total amount of Rs. 30,000/- was disbursed among top ten girls students of the college under the scheme of General Merit Scholarship and Rs. 77000/- was disbursed under meritorious and merit renewal scheme of Government of Haryana. Cases of students of B.C. Category have been processed online and the scholarship is to be transferred direct in their accounts by DGHE office.
