UG Programs

The college is currently offering three undergraduate (UG) programs viz., Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) and Bachelor of Science in Physical Sciences (formerly known as B.Sc.-Non Medical) with 240, 160 and 80 maximum number of seats respectively. The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and Bachelor of Science Physical Sciences are being offered under multi-disciplinary scheme while Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) is being offered under inter-disciplinary scheme of NEP-2020. The college offers 32 subject combinations in Bachelor of Arts and one subject combination in Bachelor of Physical Science, each subject combination including discipline specific three core courses and one minor course. Other than this, the students have to study one multi-disciplinary course, one skill enhancement course, one ability enhancement course and one value added course in both semesters of first year. 1. Admissions in UG Programs shall be as per National Education Policy 2020 (NEP-2020).
2. Applicants have to pay one time non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 100/-.
3. Tuition Fee of all Girls and all SC students of Haryana is Zero.
4. Applicants will be required to submit the following document during online application as well as during physical document verification in the college at the time of admission

- SMS/Email alert sent to the candidates if Objection is raised. In that case, applicant need to remove the objection and submit the form again.

- Rank generation on the basis of Qualification Marks + Weightage.

Guidelines for Applicants

1. **Link for Online Admission Portal is <https://admissions.highereduhry.ac.in>**
2. Non-refundable Registration Fee of Rs. 100/- shall be charged from all the applicants during session 2024-25 on the same pattern as in 2023-24 session
3. The applicants must check all the details filled in the application form very minutely before final submission of application form. Still if some mistake has been done by the applicant and the application form is also finally submitted, his/her registration shall be cancelled by the Department depending upon the justification given by the applicant on mail id admissions@highereduhry.com (*Note: - Fee deducted during the previous registration shall not be refunded back to the applicant*). After cancellation of previous registration, the applicant can register again for the admission process (*Note: - Registration fee will be again charged from the applicant for fresh registration*).
4. PPP shall remain mandatory for Haryana students for taking admissions in Degree Colleges. Also, the caste/reservation/financial benefits given to the candidate shall be on the basis of verified caste/income fetched through PPP. Any unverified data of PPP of the candidate shall lead to his candidature considered in general category only.
5. Late fee will be charged from the applicants admitted during Open Counselling as follows: -

Late Fee (1 st week during Open Counselling)	Rs. 100/-
From 2 nd Week onwards during Open Counselling	Rs. 100/- + Rs. 100/ Per day

6. Weightage, wherever applicable, shall be given to the applicant after verification of the documents and the maximum weightage of 10 shall be added to the percentage.
7. List of Documents to be uploaded online by the applicant:
 - Scanned copy of passport size photograph
 - Scanned copy of signature
 - 10th Marksheet / 12th Marksheet, wherever applicable

- Migration Certificate (required in case of other than Haryana School Education Board)
- Character Certificate
- NCC 'B' Certificate or NSS Merit Certificate, if applicable
- Bharat Scouts & Guides Certificate awarded by the President of India, if applicable
- Sports Certificate for weightage, if applicable, will only be considered, if the candidate produces the State/National position holder certificate from the respective State Government/Sports Department. In case, any state does not issue the Graduation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted:

- a) In case of International/National participation or State Position Holder, a certificate of authenticity will be required from the concerned National Federation/State Association.
- b) The game/event must be in the scheduled list of the Association of Indian University Sports Calendar.
- c) The tournament must be organised by a recognised Federation/Association duly affiliated with State Olympic Association/ Indian Olympic Association and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.

No weightage will be given for participating/winning positions in the sports and games organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra, /CBSE National, VidyaBharti Nationals/ Rural Tournaments/ Panchayat Tournaments/ Navodaya Nationals and participation in non- recognised tournaments/ sports festivals.

- Bonafide Resident of Haryana Certificate, if applicable
 - Reserved Category Certificate, if applicable
 - Income Certificate required for claiming benefits under various categories viz. EWS/SC/BC etc., if applicable
 - Gap Year Undertaking/Affidavit, if applicable
8. Name of the applicant will appear in the Merit List after online verification of documents as per eligibility/merit.
 9. General category students can now opt the benefit of EWS (Economically Weaker Section) reservation within State Quota and All India Quota as per Government norms. However, they need to upload the required certificate for the same.
 10. After appearance of name of student in merit list, he/she will have to make the payment of admission fee/funds as per admission schedule.
 11. The students will be initially given provisional admission only, subject to the verification of their documents by the College/Affiliating University. In case of any discrepancy at any stage, the college is authorized to cancel the provisional admission of the student without

any notice or the college can change his/her stream/subjects subject to availability of seats and willingness of the applicant. Even the College / University can cancel any such admission wherever the information provided by the students is found to be fictitious /bogus at any stage and the student concerned shall be held solely responsible for this.

12. If any document of a student is rejected due to some reasons during the process of online verification, a SMS will be sent to the applicant and applicant will be required to make necessary corrections on the online admission portal by logging in his/her account within prescribed timeframe.
13. In case of courses having multiple subject combinations (≥ 3), it shall be made mandatory for candidates to choose minimum 3 subject combinations in one college/different colleges at the time of filling the admission form.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

Undergraduate Programmes:

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the UG Programme

(i) Bachelor of Arts:

- Students who pass their 10+2 Examination with English as one of subject.
- If a student wants to opt mathematics as major subject, he/she must have passed mathematics as a subject in senior secondary examination (10+2).

(ii) Bachelor of Science in Physical Sciences

- Students who pass their 10+2 Examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.

(iii) Bachelor of Commerce

- Students who pass their 10+2 Examination with English.

WEIGHTAGE GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

1. Weightage*, wherever applicable, would be given after verification of the uploaded documents and the applicant shall be provided with a maximum weightage of 10 marks.

- For B.Com. 1st Semester, Students who have passed 10+2 examinations with commerce (5 marks)
- N.S.S. Merit Certificate Holder (5marks) OR
- N.C.C Cadets who possess the 'B' Certificate (5marks)

OR

Holders of Bharat Scouts & Guides Certificate awarded by the President of India (for admission to under graduate course only) (5marks)

OR

Sports Certificate for the admission to UG courses. (5 marks)

Guidelines for Sports Weightage

Sports Certificate for weightage will only be considered, if the candidate produces the State/National position holder certificate from the respective State Government/Sports Department. In case, any state does not issue the Gradation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted:

- a) In case of International/National participation or State Position Holder, a certificate of authenticity will be required from the concerned National Federation/State Association.
- b) The game/event must be in the scheduled list of the Association of Indian University Sports Calendar (Appendix L).
- c) The tournament must be organised by a recognised Federation/Association duly affiliated with State Olympic Association/ Indian Olympic Association and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.

No weightage will be given for participating/winning positions in the sports and games organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra/CBSE National, Vidya Bharti Nationals/ Rural Tournaments/ Panchayat Tournaments/ Navodaya Nationals and participation in non-recognised tournaments/ sports festivals.

As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided to the concerned category.	

Note: (i) The reservation of seats as per reservation policy of Haryana Government and is subject to any change/amendment by the State Government from time to time.

- (ii) Where a seat set aside for candidate from Deprived Scheduled Castes for admission in Government Educational Institutions is not filled up in academic year due to non-availability of candidate of Deprived Scheduled Castes possessing the requisite qualifications, the same shall be made available to candidate of Scheduled Castes. Reserved seats will not be carried forward to next year.
- (iii) Remaining instructions for reservation shall remain the same as already notified by the State Government from time to time.

GUIDELINES FOR RESERVATION

1. **The reservation of seats is as per the Reservation Policy of Haryana Govt. and is subject to change/amendment made by the State Govt. from time to time.**

2. Candidates belonging to SC/ST are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as per **Appendix-A**. The list of Deprived Scheduled Castes notified by the Haryana Government, is available at **Appendix-I**.

3. Candidates belonging to Backward Classes are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as per **Appendix-B**. The list of Backward Classes in Haryana notified by the Haryana Government is available at **Appendix-F**. Circular no. 1170-SW (1)-95 dated 7.6.95 of the Haryana Govt. for excluding Socially Advanced Persons/Sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes may be referred to at **Appendix-G**.

4. The children or grand children (Maternal & Paternal) of Freedom Fighters are required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as per **Appendix-C**.

5. Only those candidates who have permanent disability of not less than 40% (being otherwise fit for admission to the program) will be considered for admission as Physically Handicapped. They will submit a certificate from the competent authority as per **Appendix-E**.

6. Children or Wards of Military Personnel (including personnel of Para-Military Forces killed in Action or Permanently Disabled in Action and Boarded Out from the Services or Ex- Servicemen and their wards will be considered for reservation. They will submit a certificate as per **Appendix-D**. The following categories of personnel of Territorial Army are included in the definition of Ex-Servicemen in terms of the State Govt. letter No. 12/18/2006-GS-II dated 8-01- 2008:

- i) Pension holders for continuous embodied service
- ii) Persons with disability attributable to military service
- iii) Gallantry Award Winners and

iv) Such recruits boarded out/released on medical grounds and granted medical/ disability pension.

7. A candidate who applies for a reserved category or for both reserved and general categories will be considered first in general category. In case, he is not selected in general category, he will be considered for reserved category.

The Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes candidates who get selected /admitted in Educational/Professional/Technical Institutions and Universities in open competition on the basis of their own merit, will not be counted against the quota reserved for scheduled caste/ backward classes, rather they will be treated as open competition candidates. However, such candidates shall fulfill condition of eligibility regarding age etc. as are meant for general category candidates (Memo No.13864-75 dated 24.8.2012 received from the Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Welfare of Scheduled Caste and Backward Classes Department, Chandigarh).

8. If a candidate belongs to more than one reserved category, he/she shall be required to give his/her preference at the time of filling up the admission form. Preference once given shall not be changed.

9. If any seat remains vacant in sub-categories of BC (A) and BC (B), the same will be filled up through the candidates belonging to General Category. For example, if any seat in BC (B) category remains vacant, the same will be filled up from BC (A) category and vice-versa.

10. If any seat remains vacant in sub-categories of SC, the same will be filled up through the candidates belonging to other sub category of SC. For example, if any seat in SC category remains vacant, the same will be filled up from Deprived SC category and vice-versa.

10. Benefit of reservation will be given to all the reserved categories upto 2nd Merit List. In case if reserved seats other than SC seats are vacant even after 2nd Merit List, then these vacant seats will be thrown open to Haryana General Category. In case, the seats in Haryana General Category remain vacant at the end the same will be thrown open to All India Open Category.

Instructions for Physical Open Counselling 2024-25
By Department of Higher Education

1. Physical Open Counselling for vacant seats will start from 15.07.2024. The interested students shall have to report at College for participation in Physical Open Counselling.
2. Course wise comprehensive “**Waiting List of Interested Students**” along with phone numbers will be provided to the respective colleges on daily basis in their College Login on the Admission Portal. The first list shall contain all the interested applicants who applied on or before the last date of registration (i.e. 25.06.2024). The fresh registrations/editing of forms for open counselling shall start after issuance of first list and such applicants will be considered in subsequent lists (i.e. 16.07.2024 onwards) along with old applicants.
3. “**Waiting List of Interested Students**” shall contain all the candidates who have applied in your college in different courses irrespective of the fact that he has taken admission or not.
4. College will conduct Open Physical Counselling at their own level to prepare and display the Merit List thereof w.e.f. 15.07.2024 (daily basis, if required) as per affiliating University/Government norms. The account of filled/vacant seats (category-wise) shall be managed by colleges only during Physical Open Counselling. **State Reservation policy shall be implemented in letter and spirit.**
5. The College will **offer the seat** (i.e. enable the payment option) to the selected candidates on the admission portal – where the college will enter the registration No and fetch basic details & click on offer the seat/enable the fee payment option.
 - a. Candidate has to pay the fee (book the seat) on the same day on which the seat is offered by the college.
 - b. Candidate will be shown the list of all colleges/courses in the student login where the seat has been offered based on the open merit lists displayed by colleges.

Note: *The college shall ensure the eligibility checking and document verification w.r.t. the student. A declaration to this effect will be taken from the colleges that the application form along with supporting documents has been verified and the student is found eligible as per norms.*

6. **Govt. College:** In case of booking the seat in Govt. College, applicant can make payment using online mode (*by 12:00 night*) or offline mode (*during working hours of college*).
 - a. **In case of ONLINE Payment by the candidate:-**
 - i. The applicant will be displayed with a following message in student login: “*You can also make the payment in cash mode (today only) at college counter to book your seat. In order to avoid from any issue, contact immediately with the college without any delay. Otherwise, you can also make the payment online from this window only*”.

- ii. If the candidate has been allotted seat in the merit 1 or 2, it will be cancelled by the system (A declaration will be taken from the candidate that “*Seat allocated to me in merit 1 or 2 will stands cancelled and I wish to book my fresh seat through open counselling/merit list*”).

b. In case of OFFLINE/CASH Payment by the candidate:-

- i. There will be a provision in the college login (i.e. **Open Counselling Module**) where the concerned college will input the registration No and fetch the basic details and proceed to the offline payment option.
 - ii. If the candidate has been allotted seat in the merit 1 or 2, it will be cancelled by the system (A declaration will be taken from the college stating that “*The candidate has given consent before the college authorities that the seat allocated to me in merit 1 or 2 stands cancelled and the candidate wish to book fresh seat through open counselling/merit list*”).
7. The students who took admission earlier in Merit 1 or 2 and now opted to book the seat through Physical Open Counselling, their admission from previous college/course **shall be automatically cancelled**. In this case, the refund will be initiated by the previous college as per norms where the student took admission/book seat in Merit 1 or 2.
8. It is pertinent to mention here that, suppose a student has booked a seat and made the payment in some college/course in Physical Open Counselling on first day and now, say on third day, he wants to again participate in Open Counselling and book his seat in some other college/course, then his admission in previous college/course **shall not be automatically cancelled**. **In this case, the student has to physically visit in the college to get his seat cancelled in order to book the seat in new college/course**. The same scenario shall be applicable on all days during Physical Open Counselling.
9. Once the seat is booked by the candidate (*whether through online mode or offline mode of payment*), the receipt would be shown in the candidate’s login. Also the status of the previous allotted seat (if any) would be shown as Cancelled. The consolidated report of the students who took the admission in Physical Open Counselling shall also be visible in the college login.

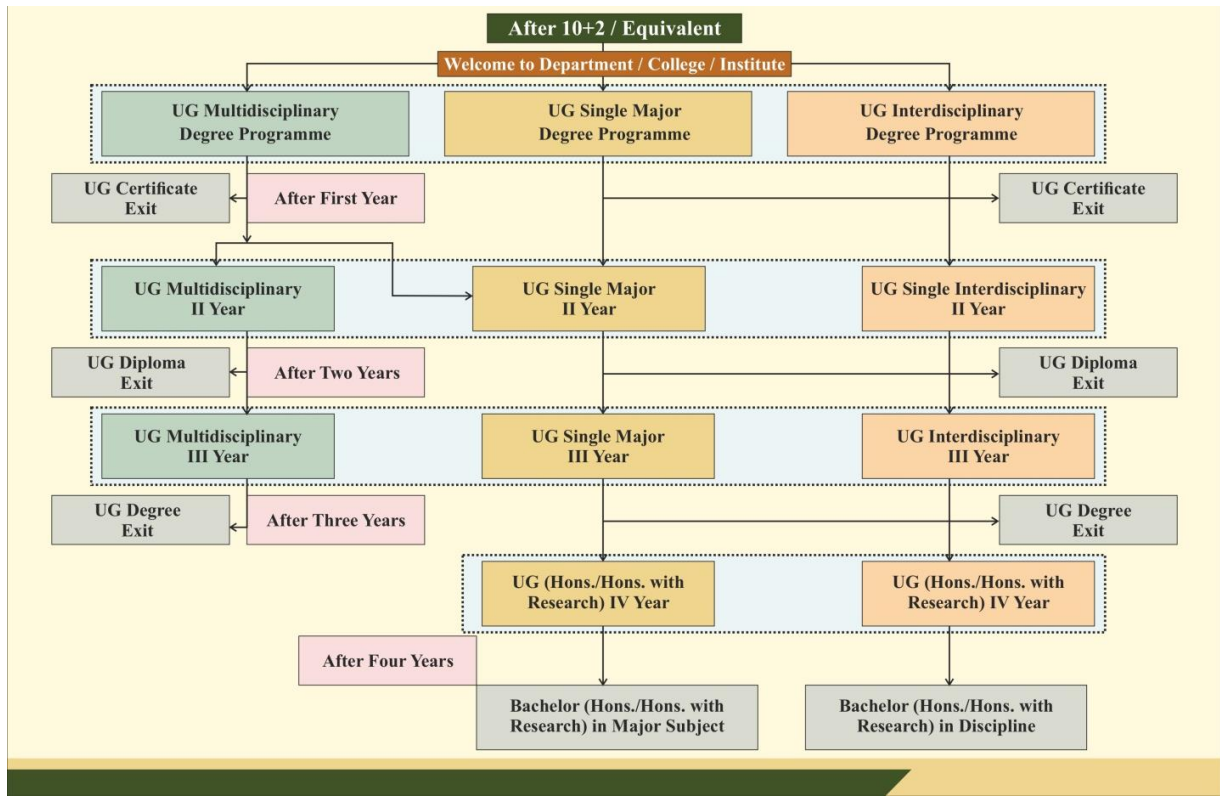

Copy of letter No. 1170-SW (I)-95 dated 7.6.95 received from the Commissioner & Secretary to Government, Haryana, Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes Department, Haryana, Chandigarh, addressed to all Heads of Departments, Commissioners, Ambala, Hisar, Rohtak and Gurugram Divisions, all Deputy Commissioners & Sub Divisional Officers in Haryana and Registrar, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh.

Sub: Exclusion of socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the subject mentioned above and to state that following the Supreme Court judgment in the Indira Sawhney and others versus Union of India case, the Haryana Government vide notification dated 12.10.1993 had set up the Haryana Second Backward Classes Commission. The terms of reference of this Commission were to entertain, examine and recommend upon requests for inclusion and complaints of over-inclusion and under-inclusion in the list of Backward Classes. Vide notification dated 26-5-1994, the Commission was also assigned the function of specifying the basis, applying the relevant and requisite socio-economic criteria to exclude socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes.

In its report submitted on 16.5.1995, the Haryana Second Backward Classes Commission had recommended the criteria for excluding socially advanced persons/sections (Creamy Layer) from Backward Classes. After considering these recommendations, the Government has decided that the benefit of reservation shall not apply to persons/sections mentioned in Appendix H which is enclosed.

All the departments are requested to bring the above instructions to the notice of all the Heads of Departments and appointing authorities under their control for necessary compliance.

Description of Category

I. Constitutional Posts

- b) A lady belonging to OBC category has got married to a Class-I Officer and may herself like to apply for a job.

B.

Son(s) and daughter(s) of

- a) parents both of whom are Class-II Officers.
- b) parents of whom only the husband is a Class-I Officer and he gets into Class-I at the age of 40 or earlier.
- c) parents, both of whom are Class- II officers and one of them dies or suffers permanent incapacitation and either one of them has had the benefit of employment in any Inter-national Organization like UN, IMF, World Bank, etc. for a period of not less than 5 years before such death or permanent incapacitation;
- d) parents of whom the husband is a Class- I Officer (direct recruit or pre-forty promoted) and the wife is a Class-II officer and the wife dies or suffers permanent incapacitation; and
- e) parents, of whom the wife is a Class I officer (Direct Recruit or pre-forty promoted) and the husband is a Class-II officer & the husband dies or suffers permanent incapacitation.

Provided that the rule of exclusion shall not apply in the following cases:

Sons and daughters of

- a) parents, both of whom are Class II officers and one of them dies or suffers permanent in capacitating.
- b) parents, both of whom are Class-II officers and both of them die or suffer permanent incapacitation, even though either of them has had the benefit of employment in any Inter-national Organization like UN, IMF, World Bank, etc. for a period of not less than 5 years before their death or permanent incapacitation.

C.

The criteria enumerated in A & B above in this Category will apply *mutatis mutandi* to officers holding equivalent or comparable posts in PSUs, Banks, Insurance Organizations, Universities, etc. pending the evaluation of the posts on equivalent or comparable basis in these institutions, the criteria specified in Category V below will apply to the officers in these Institutions.

III

Sons(s) and daughter(s) of parents either or both of whom is or are in the rank of Colonel and above in the army and to equivalent posts in the Navy and the Air Force and the Para Military Forces:

Provided that -

- i) If the wife of an Armed Forces Officer is herself in the

- Armed Forces (i.e., the category under consideration), the rule of exclusion will apply only when she herself has reached the rank of Colonel;
- ii) the service ranks below Colonel of husband and wife shall not be clubbed together;
 - iii) If the wife of an officer in the Armed Forces is in Civil employment, this will not be taken into account for applying the rule of exclusion unless she falls in the service category under item No. II in which case the criteria and conditions enumerated therein will apply to her independently.
- IV Son(s) and daughter(s) of persons belonging to a family (father, mother and minor children) which owns land more than land permissible under the Ceiling Act of Haryana State.
- V Income/Wealth Tax Son(s) and daughter(s) of:
- a) Persons having gross annual income of Rs. 6.00 lakhs or above or possessing wealth above the exemption limit as prescribed in the Wealth Tax Act for a period of three consecutive years. (Range of income has been revised from Rs. 4.50 lakhs to Rs. 6.00 lakhs vide Chief Secretary letter No. 22/22/2004-3GS-III dated 06.01.2014/14.06.2016).
 - b) Persons in Categories I, II, III & IV who are not disentitled to the benefit of reservation but have income from other sources of wealth which will bring them within the income/wealth criteria mentioned in (a) above.

Explanation:

- i) Income from salaries or agricultural land shall not be clubbed;
- ii) The income criteria in terms of rupee will be modified taking into account the change in its value every three years. If the situation, however, so demands, the interregnum may be less.
- iii) Where the husband is in some profession and the wife is in a Class II or lower grade employment, the income/wealth test will apply only on the basis of the husband's income.
- iv) If the wife is in any profession and the husband is in employment in a Class II or lower rank post, then the income/wealth criterion will apply only on the basis of the wife's income and the husband's income will not be clubbed with it.

Explanation: Wherever the expression, 'permanent incapacitation' occurs in this schedule it shall mean incapacitation which results in putting an Officer out of service.

. How can I apply for on the Centralized Admission Portal ?

Any candidate who desires to seek admission to UG/PG courses in the colleges affiliated to state universities of Haryana can visit on admission.highereduhry.ac.in to access the portal for registration and login to fill the admission form. The online portal shall direct the candidate to an integrated admission form.

Is there any entrance test for centralized admission?

There is no entrance test for courses under centralized admissions in various colleges of Haryana. The admission will be done on the basis of merit i.e. marks obtained in last qualifying exam + weightage if any

What particulars are required for registration?

Applicant's Email ID, Applicant's Personal Mobile Number, Applicant's Name (Name must be same as in Class-10th marks sheet/certificate) and Gender.

I have submitted incorrect Basic Registration Details. How can I get them edited?

Basic Registration Details cannot be edited.

How much is Registration fee?

Registration charges are Rs. 100/- (Non-Refundable).

Whether Registration fee is refundable or not?

Registration fee is non-refundable.

Can I pay the Registration charges/ College Fee offline?

There is no provision for offline payment.

I have paid the registration charges and the amount has been deducted from my Bank Account but the Payment Status has not been updated yet; what should I do?

Candidates who have successfully paid the registration charges and the amount has been deducted from their Bank Account should check their account statement before paying registration charges again.

What is significance of PPP?

Parivar Pehchaan Patra (PPP) shall be required for registration towards admission for Haryana residents.

What are the documents required?

Scanned copy of Passport size photograph, signature, 10th Marksheet, 12th Marksheet, Migration Certificate (required in case of other than Haryana School Education Board), Weightage Certificate if any, Income Certificate if applicable, Bonafide Resident of Haryana Certificate, if applicable, Reserved Category Certificate if applicable, Gap Year Undertaking/Affidavit, if applicable

What is the minimum age required?

There is no age limit for eligible students.

Can I apply for admission to different colleges through one online form?

Yes, Candidate can apply for different colleges with the same User ID and Password.

Can I apply for admission to different courses in the same institution?

Yes, a candidate can apply for multiple courses within an college or different colleges with the same User ID and Password.

Can I apply in several courses at a time?

Yes, a candidate can apply for multiple courses at a time. One can choose up to five colleges and up to five courses in each college. The candidate can further select a minimum of three and up to as many Subject Combinations/Grouping as he/she wants. Further it is advised that candidate should choose maximum number of subject Combinations/Grouping in order to maximize the chances of their admission.

My school used CGPA scale. How do I fill in the CGPA section in the online application?

The provision of entering CGPA has been provided in the online application form.

Are students from outside Haryana eligible to register?

Yes, students from outside Haryana are also eligible to apply for admission in various courses running at different colleges as per affiliating university/state government norms.

Outside Haryana students can compete in how many seats?

Outside Haryana students can compete within 15% seats under All India Quota.

Are Non-Indian students allowed?

Yes, they are allowed subject to fulfilment of norms of college/affiliating university/state government norms.

What reservation rules apply for admission in any program?

All reservations benefits would be given as per Haryana State Reservation policy.

If a candidate applies within reserved category, then under which category he shall be considered first during generation of merit lists?

A candidate who applies within reserved, he will be considered first in the general category. In case, he is not selected in the general category, then he will be considered for the reserved category for which he has applied.

What if a candidate is covered under more than one reserved category/subcategory?

If a candidate is covered under more than one reserved category/subcategory, he will be considered first in the general category. In case, he is not selected in the general category, then he will be considered for the reserved category/subcategory as per State Reservation Policy.

What if the student fails to register before the deadline?

A student may register / apply for online admission even after the deadline during open counselling only for the leftover seats.

- NCC Cadets who possess the 'B' Certificate
- Holders of Bharat Scouts & Guide Certificate awarded by the President of India
- Holder of Sports Certificate
- NSS Merit Certificate Holder in 12th Class
- Institute situated in Rural Area of Haryana from where you passed the 12th/Equivalent Diploma

Which type of sports certificate is valid for claim of weightage.

Sports Certificate for weightage, if applicable, will only be considered, if the candidate produces the State/National position holder certificate from the respective State Government/Sports Department. In case, any state does not issue the Gradation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted:

- In case of International/National participation or State Position Holder, a certificate of authenticity will be required from the concerned National Federation/State Association.
- The game/event must be in the scheduled list of the Association of Indian University Sports Calendar.
- The tournament must be organised by a recognised Federation/Association duly affiliated with State Olympic Association/ Indian Olympic Association and Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- *No weightage will be given for participating/winning positions in the sports and games organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra, CBSE National, Vidya Bharti Nationals/ Rural Tournaments/ Panchayat Tournaments/ Navodaya Nationals and participation in non-recognised tournaments/ sports festivals.*

How much is the maximum weightage.

10 Marks, if applicable.

What is the process of generation of Merit List.

Merit lists shall be prepared after considering marks of best five subjects in the qualifying examination including weightage and as per State Reservation Policy. In addition, provision of "Defer" the allotted seat by the applicant in the 1st Merit List for reconsideration in 2nd Merit List will be provided subject to the condition that the applicant did not get his first choice in 1st merit list.

How does the waiting process work?

After the First and the Second Merit list, if seats still remain vacant, the admissions will be allowed through online open counselling on merit basis.

Where can I see the status of allotment of seats?

The status of allotment of seats can be checked under "Know Your Result" tab on centralized admissions portal.

What are the options for College fee payment available after allotment of seat?

Government Colleges: The fees can be paid through Online mode (UPI / Debit Card / Credit Card / Net-banking) only.

Aided & Self Finance Colleges: The fees can be paid through Offline (depositing of Cash at College) or through Online mode (UPI / Debit Card / Credit Card / Net-banking) mode.

What if I fail to deposit the fee within the time period of allotment of seat?

The seat will be de-allocated.

What is the process of refund to students.

Refund, if any, to the students shall be ensured by the Colleges as per affiliating University/State Government norms. The college is also authorized to take the short payment, if any, from the student at later stage as per norms.

Is there any provision of financial assistance for the needy students?

My result has been declared, but I do not have my mark sheet. What document should I upload?

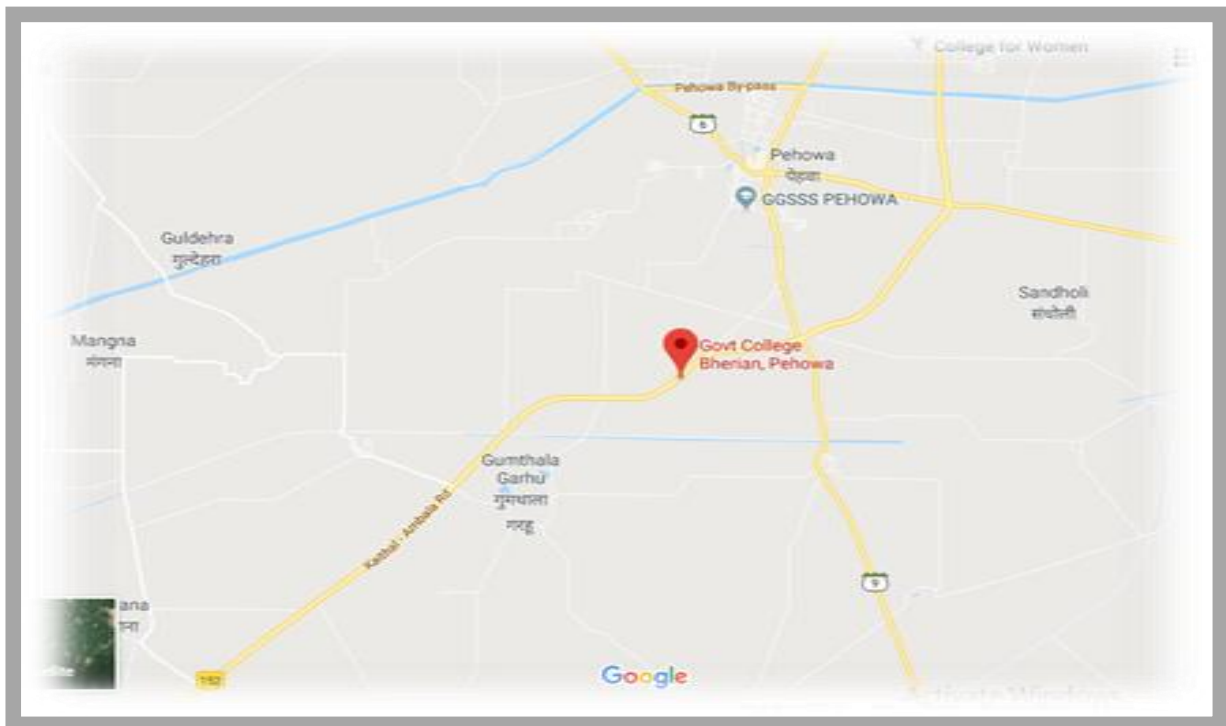
